9. INTRODUCTION OF GUEST SPEAKER - Dick Smith
Speaker: Daniel Warvi, Public Affairs Officer for VA Eastern Colo Health System
Topic: Veteran's Administration 101. The VA is second only to the DOD in size of budget. It has three operational areas: Benefits, Health Care and Cemeteries. ECHS covers nine states, four entirely. Their objective is to serve locally, and they operate thirteen health facilities in their area.

Mr. Warvi described the new VA hospital under construction at the Fitzsimmons Medical Center, its construction and budget problems. It is presently 60% complete and he estimates a 2017 completion. It will have 120 patient beds, 30 for its Spinal Cord Injury specialty. VA supports the DOD in time of war.
