

Each Memorial Day and Veterans' Day, AABC-MOAA, joins with the NROTC detachment of the University of Colorado, to place an American flag on the grave of each veteran, buried at Columbia Cemetery in Boulder, Colorado. AABC-MOAA provides the flags and keeps track of the locations, of each grave, so that the Midshipmen can place flags, at the appropriate markers.

By using simple maps and photos (samples below) on the day before the placing of the flags, an advance squad of Midshipmen finds the veteran's grave site and places a marker flag there, so that when the entire Corps arrives, the American flags can be placed quickly. There are more than 300 graves to be identified and flagged. The flags remain in place, through the day the holidays are observed and are then retrieved by a select squad of Midshipmen. Other organizations place flags at the other Boulder cemeteries for Memorial Day.
